- Spiritual connection gained through discussion, activities and events can provide hope, lessen feelings of isolation and be a springboard to promote other healthy behaviors.

WHAT YOUR FAITH COMMUNITY CAN DO

CONNECT WITH YOUR LEADERSHIP AND:

- Ask how (if) your congregation supports veterans and their families.
- Invite them to join you and learn more about how to support and refer military families in your congregation and community.
- Share https://www.ConnectVeterans.org/faith with them to better understand special ways the faith community supports veterans and their families.

GET YOUR LOCAL COMMUNITY INVOLVED:

- Ensure key staff, volunteers and community members have the Be Connected support line number: 866-4AZ-VETS (429-8387). Anyone can call this support line Monday through Friday from 8 AM 5 PM to connect service members, veterans and their families to resources. If someone calls after hours they will be directed to leave a message or select 1 to connect with the crisis line.
- Let people know that Be Connected offers complimentary "Resource Navigator" training to everyone to teach citizens how to connect service members, veterans and their families to the resources they need.
